ACCA Oualification

The ACCA was founded in 1904 and is a member of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC). It seeks to offer business-relevant qualifications in accounting, finance, and management to people around the world, while upholding its core values of opportunity, diversity innovation, integrity, and accountability.

ACCA Qualification Structure

To achieve the ACCA Qualification students are required to pass the following three levels of the ACCA program – Applied Knowledge, Applied Skills, and Strategic Professional.

Applied Knowledge

This level is the focuses on core areas of financial and management accounting.

Applied Skills

This level contains six subjects which comprehensively cover the main technical areas that any accountant are expected to be proficient. These comprise law, performance management, taxation, financial reporting, auditing, and financial management.

Strategic Professional

This level consists of Essentials and Options modules. The Essentials consists of a case study, Strategic Business Leader, and the Strategic Business Reporting paper. For the Options modules, students are required to choose two from four papers: Advanced Financial Management, Advanced Performance Management, Advanced Taxation or Advanced Audit and Assurance.

Both modules are intellectually equivalent to taking a Masters degree in the United Kingdom with the focus of building upon the technical skills already acquired, and explore more advanced professional skills, techniques, and values as expected in accountants in an senior advisory or consultancy role. All students must complete the two papers in the Essentials module.

The Options module papers are directly complemented by their equivalents within the Applied Skills module in the Fundamentals level. These exams assess the more advanced and sophisticated techniques that a professional needs.

Exemptions

Students from ACCA-recognized educational institutions can get exemptions from taking certain papers or exams in achieving their ACCA qualification. Educational institutions are therefore also encouraged to provide their entry requirements and information about their undergraduate and post-graduate programs to be formally recognized by ACCA.

ACCA Qualification Structure

Applied Knowledge

This level is the focuses on core areas of financial and management accounting.


Applied Skills

Strategic Professional


This level consists of Essentials and Options modules. The Essentials consists of a case study, Strategic Business Leader, and the Strategic Business Reporting paper.

FOUNDATION-LEVEL OUALIFICATIONS

The Foundation level qualifications are also designed as pathways or steppingstones towards the ACCA Qualification for those who aim to achieve ACCA membership, but who do not currently have the minimum academic qualifications to apply directly to the ACCA Qualification. Depending on the level at which a student registers, they can gain valuable qualifications as they progress, which in turn leads to recognition and reward for the knowledge and skills they have gained. The qualifications also provide good underpinning knowledge to help students better prepare for the ACCA Qualification exams.

Program structure

Strategic Business Leader (SBL)

The aim of the syllabus is to demonstrate organizational leadership and senior consultancy, or advisory capabilities and relevant professional skills, through the context of an integrated case study.

Strategic Business Reporting (SBR)

The financial reporting syllabus assumes knowledge acquired in Financial Accounting (FA) and develops and applies this further and in greater depth.

Advanced Audit and Assurance (AAA)

The aim of the syllabus is to analyze, evaluate and conclude on the assurance engagement and other audit and assurance issues in the context of best practice and current developments.

- Completion, review and reporting
- Planning and conducting an audit of historical financial information

Advanced Financial Management (AFM)

The aim of the syllabus is to apply relevant knowledge, skills and exercise professional judgement as expected of a senior financial executive or advisor, in taking or recommending decisions relating to the financial management of an organization in private and public sectors.

Modules:

- Role of senior financial adviser in the multinational organization
- · Advanced investment appraisal
- · Acquisition and mergers
- Corporate reconstruction and re-organization
- Treasury and advanced risk management techniques

Study duration:

The program can be completed in 12 months.

Exams:

The professional level requires you to undertake 4 exams.

This includes two compulsory modules which include Strategic Business Leader and Strategic Business Reporting. You then need to choose two further courses that suit your career ambitions from Advanced Financial Management; Advanced Performance Management; or Advanced Audit and Assurance.

The syllabus is assessed by a three-hour fifteen-minute examination. The pass mark for all ACCA Qualification examinations is 50%.

The Strategic Business Leader syllabus is examined using a 100% integrated case study, examining across a breadth of organizational functions. The examination is of 4 hours duration.



Who should attend:

This program is intended for professional accountants and auditors working in practice and industry and qualified in national accounting standards are eligible to take the qualification.

Students who successfully complete the Diploma in Accounting and Business and the Certified Accounting Technician (CAT) qualification via the Foundation level route can then transfer to the ACCA qualification.

Delivery format: Online and blended learning


